Finalization of the IRES.Forum report 2019

This document presents the reports of the international conferences and meetings organized by IRES in 2019, relating to national issues, Morocco's external relations and global issues with structural dimension as well as those relating to the presentation and discussion of recent works dealing with strategic questions.

The global health crisis

After the 2019 strategic report on the new development model, which had emphasized the need to change the relationship between man and nature and the importance of a more humane economy, IRES a started a deep reflection on the consequences of the Covid-19 pandemic and on the configuration of the post-crisis world.

The future of relations between Morocco and the European Union

IRES received the provisional report of the first phase of this study, which consists of carrying out a survey on the perception of the image of Morocco within the European institutions. This survey was carried out by the Center for European, Policy Studies (CEPS).

The water issue in the Souss-Massa region according to the NEXUS approach

After the national study on the issue of water completed, at the end of 2019, the provisional report of the regional study was prepared. The purpose of this report is to propose innovative strategies for rational and equitable management, at the level of the Souss-Massa hydraulic basin, of water resource needs within the framework of a NEXUS approach.


